Pictures of people and animals, cups, small and large toys, baskets or containers, animal figures, muffin cups (Interest Area)

Self-Regulation

Box with small toys such as Excellerations® Sensory Surprise Box with 5 Shapes (Options 1, 2)

Medium-sized, open cardboard box; assortment of familiar, small toys (Interest Area)

Social-Emotional

2 similar or identical dolls (Option 1)

2 baskets (Option 1)

2 small blankets (Option 1)

4–6 people figures (Option 2)

3 boxes (shoe or tissue box size)(Option 2)

Large fabric or felt pieces (Option 2)

Several strips of contact paper (Interest Area)

Physical/Health

4 mats of different textures—Examples: a braided rug; an infant play mat with waffle texture; a soft, bumpy infant bath mat; and a small area rug with unique textures (Options 1, 2)

Several small infant toys (Option 1)

Texture toys and items including bears, balls, books, basket (Interest Area)
